#### **Matched Club Agreement**

By and Between -

Rotary Club of Port Moresby, RI District 9600, Papua New Guinea  
represented by its RY 2000-01 President Dale Palmer

and

Rotary Club of Brisbane , RI District 9600, Australia  
represented by its RY 2000-01 President Brian W Carss  
with mailing address at 7 Kyoga St, Kenmore, Qld 4069.

WHEREAS, the above Rotary Clubs, have established contact with each other for the purpose of fostering International understanding and goodwill under the R.I. Rotary Friendship Exchange Program; and

WHEREAS, their respective Boards of Directors/Club Assemblies have formally approved the establishment of. a matched Club relationship between them;

NOW THEREFORE in consideration of the foregoing premises, the above-named Rotary Clubs hereby agree as follows:

#### **Article 1**

##### **Nature and Term of the Matched Club Agreement**

- i.1 This agreement hereby establishes a Matched Club relationship between the parties for the purpose of fostering international friendship, understanding and goodwill through shared programs, activities and projects relevant to Rotary's ideals under the framework of the four avenues of service.
- 1.2 This agreement covers the Rotary Years of 2001 to 2003, culminating at the end of the latter Rotary year.
- 1.3 The matched club relationship may be renewed by means of a written Renewal of Matched Club Agreement upon mutual agreement of the parties concerned.
- 1.4 This agreement may be rescinded anytime upon formal notice of any party to the other that a decision to do so was officially made by the Club's Board of Directors or Club Assembly.

**Article 2**  
**Activities Between the Parties**

2.1 Under this Matched Club Agreement, both clubs hereby agree to conduct the following activities:

- Encourage friendship between their respective members through correspondence, by mail, fax, email, telephone or other means.
- Exchange copies of their respective club bulletins and other relevant Rotary-related publications.
- Encourage members travelling to each other's country to attend make-up meetings in each others clubs.
- On a best endeavour basis, endeavour to organize formal Rotary Friendship Exchange visits with each other on a regular basis to be mutually agreed upon.
- Study and jointly undertake, if feasible, other Rotary International Service projects, particularly in the areas of World Community Service, Matching Grants, Rotary Volunteers and Youth Exchange.
